The base goal projection after weighting is as follows:

Total Weighted DBE Availability: \$721,218

Total for All Trades: \$11,578,947

Dividing the weighted DBE totals by the total estimate for all trades gives a base DBE availability figure for the projects anticipated during the goal-setting period. This figure is expressed as a percentage and serves as the basis for the three-year overall goal.

Base of DBE Goal: 6.2%

Step 2: Adjustments to Step 1 base figure

Past History Participation

One piece of data used to determine the adjustment to the base figure was the median of historical DBE accomplishments, as follows:

Arranging this historical data from low to high (0.4%, 1.6%, 43.3%), the median is **1.6%**.

Step 1 Base averaged with historical median: (6.2% + 1.6%) / 2 = 3.9%

To arrive at an overall goal, the Step 1 base figure was added to the Step 2 adjustment figure and the total was averaged, arriving at an overall goal of **3.9%**. Pueblo Memorial Airport believes this adjusted goal accurately reflects DBE participation that can be achieved for the type(s) of work being awarded during the FY 2021-2023 goal period.

Breakout of Estimated "Race and Gender Neutral" (RN) and "Race and Gender Conscious" (RC) Participation

Pueblo Memorial Airport will meet the maximum feasible portion of the overall goal by using race neutral means of facilitating DBE participation.

- 1. Arranging solicitations, times for the presentation of bids, quantities, specifications, and delivery schedules in ways that facilitates DBE, and other small businesses, participation.
- 2. Carrying out information and communications programs on contracting procedures and specific contract opportunities.

Pueblo Memorial Airport estimates that in meeting the established overall goal of **3.9%**, it will obtain **1.6%** from RN participation and **2.3%** through RC measures.

This breakout is based on:

Examining past federally-funded projects at Pueblo Memorial Airport, participation by DBE's has typically not exceeded the overall DBE participation goals. The FY19 Install Perimeter Fencing project is an outlier in this respect due to the fencing subcontractor on the fencing project being a DBE, which was a major component of the project. Fencing is not within the types of work anticipated during the FY 2021-23 goal period, and therefore this high DBE participation is not anticipated in the FY 2021-23 goal period. The work performed during the FY 18 and FY 17 projects are more representative of the types of work anticipated during the FY 2021-23 goal period. Therefore, the median past DBE participation of 1.6%, accomplished through RN participation will be the basis for the breakout of estimated RN and RC participation for the FY 2021-23 goal period. Using this baseline, the City of Pueblo estimates that in meeting the established FY 2021-23 overall goal of **3.9%**, it will obtain **1.6%** from RN participation and **2.3%** through RC measures.

Pueblo Memorial Airport will adjust the estimated breakout of race neutral and race conscious DBE participation as needed to reflect actual DBE participation (see §26.51(f)) and track and report race neutral and race conscious participation separately. For reporting purposes, race neutral DBE participation includes, but is not necessarily limited to the following: DBE participation through a prime contract obtained through customary competitive procurement procedures; DBE participation through a subcontract on a prime contract that does not carry a DBE goal, DBE participation on a prime contract exceeding a contract goal, and DBE participation through a subcontract from a prime contractor that did not consider a firm's DBE status in making the award.

Consultation

In establishing the overall goal, the Pueblo Memorial Airport provided for consultation and publication. This process included consultation with minority, women's, and general contractor groups, community organizations, and other officials or organizations which could be expected to have information concerning the availability of disadvantaged and non-disadvantaged businesses, the effects of discrimination on opportunities for DBEs, and the City of Pueblo's efforts to establish a level playing field for the participation of DBEs. The consultation included a scheduled, direct, interactive exchange with as many interested stakeholders as possible focused on obtaining information relevant to the goal setting process and was conducted before the goal methodology was submitted to the operating administration for review. Details of the consultation are as follows.

The consultation was through teleconference (via Microsoft Teams), which was held on July 15, 2020 at 2:00 pm.
